(RECENT 5 YEARS – DROP 1 HIGHEST YEAR)

Township Policy Bills

2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION – HB 1236

ALLOWS TOWNSHIPS TO HOLD THEIR ANNUAL MEETING ANY DATE IN MARCH

RAISES THE MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE COMPENSATION FOR TOWNSHIP OFFICERS TO \$100 PER DAY OF NECESSARY SERVICE WITH AN ANNUAL CAP OF \$4,000

Township Policy Bills

2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION – SB 2178

Township Special Road Fund Limitations

INCREASED FROM \$100,000 TO \$500,000

THIS ALLOWS A TOWNSHIP TO SAVE UP FOR A LARGE ROAD PROJECT WITHOUT IMPACTING THEIR LEVY ABILITY
