## Township bill gets green light

**SB 2178** which gives townships authority to increase their special road fund to \$500,000 was given a DO PASS by the House Political Subdivision Committee 12-0, and will be voted on by the full House on Monday, March 6. If passed, it will be sent to the Governor's desk for consideration.
