

# 2020 HANDBOOK CORRECTION

Page 158 of the NDTOA Township Officers Handbook 2020 Edition.

A change to 57-09-01 was inadvertently missed in the update.

**NOTE:** Township Equalization Meetings shall be in the first 15 days of April. (Section 1)  
Unless the assessor serves more than one township; then the meetings shall be in the month of April. (Section 2)

## **57-09-01. Membership of board - Meeting.**

1. The township board of equalization consists of the members of the board of supervisors of each township, and the township clerk shall act as clerk of said board. The board shall meet **within the first fifteen days of April** in each year at the usual place of meeting of the township board of supervisors.
2. If the same person performs the duties of assessor for two or more townships or cities, the township clerk may, after consultation with the assessor involved, designate the hour and day in the month of April at which the meeting provided for in subsection 1 must be held for each township board of equalization; provided, that notice of the hour and day must be published in the official newspaper of the political subdivisions involved and posted at the usual place of meeting by the township clerk at least ten days before the meeting.
